

Jeff Levine, a long-time Kings Park resident, graduated from Kings Park Senior High School in 1979. During his time there he was editor-in-chief of the school newspaper, *The Kings Herald*, and was a winner of the 1979 Newsday/Alicia Paterson Award for excellence in high school journalism. He went to college at SUNY Oswego, after which he returned to LI to begin working at radio station WBAB. After 20 years at WBAB Long Island working as a disc jockey and host, Jeff was named Program and Marketing Director. In 1998 he moved on to Newsday, where he became Marketing Director, responsible for starting the noteworthy programs FutureCorps (honoring great work by local students) and Life's Victories, a fundraising and awareness program featuring breast cancer survivors.

Jeff Levine began early and worked quickly to build an impressive career in radio and newspapers. He made a name for himself in several major media markets including Long Island, Hartford, and Miami/Fort Lauderdale. In 2006, he was named Newspaper Marketer of the Year by the Newspaper Association of America. In 2009 he launched South Florida Chamber Maps and Apps, and was subsequently named local Small Business Person of the year in 2014.
