Mr. Knoetgen is currently a Manager at Future Learning Initiatives for the nuclear power industry utilizing technology to develop and deliver standardized training for nuclear workers. He is a graduate of the United States Naval Academy Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program (1979).

Upon entering the Naval Reserves in 1985, Captain Knoetgen's extensive commanding officer assignments included Naval Forces Central Command Det. 108 (NAVCENT) where he led the unit's Crisis Response Team, planning and executing Operation Enduring Freedom. Captain Knoetgen's unit supported military exercises including Bright Star, Lucky Sentinel, Internal Look, and Neon Falcon. His unit also served in
