This is a man on a fast track. A graduate of KPHS in 1998, by 2011 he is a PhD Professor of History in a first rate college. That is not only intellect, but his stamina. With the help of awards and fellowships, Philip Misevich literally took every path that provided insight and knowledge about the slave trade and the history coming from it.

His teaching areas are Pre-colonial and Modern African History, Atlantic History, Atlantic Slave Trade, Southern African History,

East Africa and the Indian Ocean, Comparative Slavery, Women in African History and Environmental History.

Presently and Assistant Professor of History at St. John's University, Philip has over a dozen written papers, TV productions and studies to his credit. His associations include the African Studies Association, American Historical Association, and the Fellow Royal Anthropological Institute.

Philip Misevich followed the path not often used. He sought something new and different. He has not only found what he desired, but he has excelled in its accomplishment. And the book hasn't been completed yet.
